HEAR

Pursuing Contentment (Hebrews 13:5-6)

Sermon Outline

Big Idea: Christians should pursue contentment by freeing themselves from the love of money, by resting in God's presence, and by confessing our confidence in His provision and help in all circumstances.

- 1. Pursue contentment by freeing our lives from the love of money (v.5a)
- 2. Pursue contentment by resting in God's presence (v.5b)
- 3. Pursue contentment by confessing our confidence in God's provision and help (v.6)

Reflect and Respond

- 1. How are we using our time and resources to better reflect what God wants our hearts to pursue?
- 2. How does knowing that God will not leave and forsake us allow us to rest in Him?
- 3. How can we mutually encourage one another in the body to pursue contentment?
